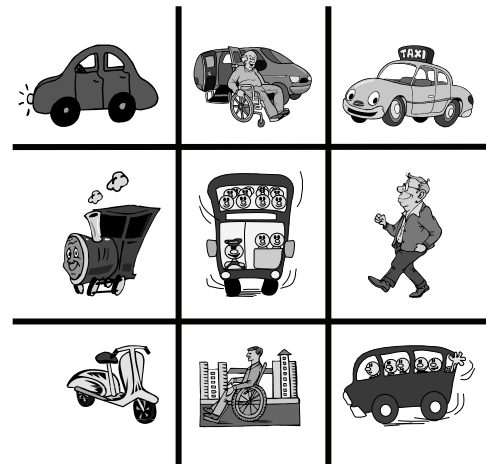

Here is what it costs to drive:

Vehicle Cost Breakdown Per Mile
 based on amount of miles driven per year/week

	Annual Vehicle Cost*	Cost Per Month	Cost Per Mile
10,000 miles/year 192 miles/week	\$6,214	\$518	\$0.62
15,000 miles/year 289 miles/week	\$7,823	\$652	\$0.52
20,000 miles/year 385 miles/week	\$9,498	\$792	\$0.48
